

How to find books

You may browse the collection by using the **Menu** or you can search for a title with the simple search at the top of the page. Click the Menu icon if you don't see the selections in the dark area below the BCLS logo.



Even better is the **Advanced Search**. The Advanced Search will let you search for a title that is currently available as well as by Subject. Genres are included in the Subject dropdown menu. You may also select a file format such as Kindle or epub.




Checkout

If the book is available for immediate checkout, you will see the **Borrow** button. Click it to check your book out. The titles you borrow will remain on your **Bookshelf** for the full duration of your checkout.
